### Does View Dynamic Glass provide a NFRC Rating Label?

NFRC certifications are obtained for the entire window assembly and not for just the insulating glass unit. **View only provides the insulating glass unit, and therefore cannot provide an NFRC label for it.** The glazier or window fabricator (whoever is responsible for providing the entire window assembly) typically provides the NFRC testing and report.

View can provide the glass performance values to the responsible party for proper modeling. Our # is **4603** in the latest International Glazing Database (IGDB) database, which is what is used for modeling in NFRC submissions.

### More Information:

The National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) has developed and operates a uniform national rating system for the energy performance of fenestration products, including windows, doors, skylights, and similar products.

The linchpin of the rating system is a procedure for determining the thermal transmittance ("U-factor") of a product. The U-factor rating procedure is supplemented by procedures for rating products for solar heat gain coefficient ("solar heat gain" or "SHGC"), visible transmittance ("VT"), air leakage ("AL"), and condensation resistance ("CR"). Together, these rating procedures, as set forth in documents published by NFRC, are known as the NFRC Rating System.
